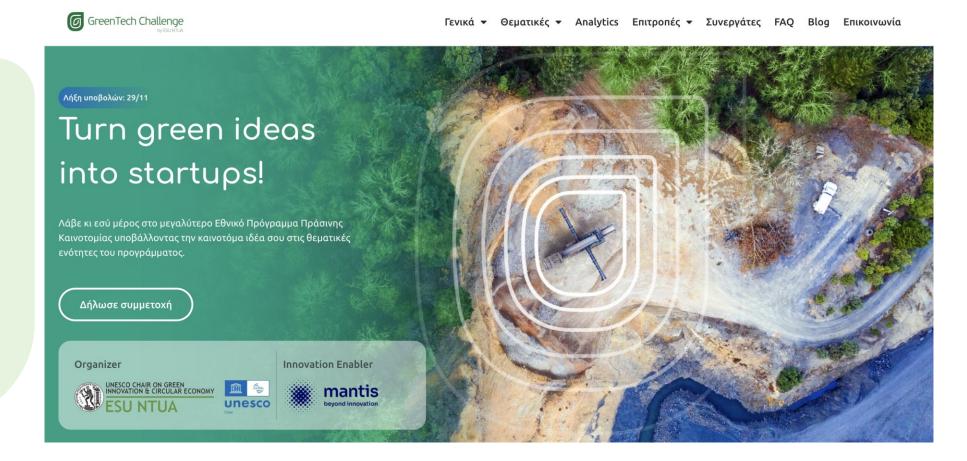

2. LAB2MARKET PROGRAM

The Lab2Market EIT RawMaterials Program is an innovation program designed to enhance the entrepreneurial skillset of EIT Labelled Master's Students, EIT RawMaterials Alumni and Ph.D. students in the RM sector to generate spin-offs and new sustainable solutions through the outcomes of their research, knowledge and experience in the sector.

The Lab2market EIT RawMaterials Program will run in 3 phases

- Ideation
- 2. Startup Development
- 3. Incubation











2. LAB2MARKET PHASES

Phase 1: Ideation Phase

- Educate participants on the principles of startups and introduce them to significant tools and methodologies to be used for startup concepts
- Identify the RawMaterials sector's challenges and generate innovative ideas to secure the sustainable supply of raw materials across the value chain: from exploration, mining and extraction to mineral processing, recycling, and the movement towards a circular economy
- Teams' formation by matchmaking the participants and compose a founding team, identify roles and upcoming needs of the team

Phase 2: Startup Development Phase

- Validate customer needs, market size and go-to-market strategy, identify regulations and other specific criteria for technical and market entrance
- Validate value proposition and complete the Business Model Canvas
- Create a solid technical concept and product roadmap
- Complete a business plan and a team to support the next phase

Green Alternatives for European Autonomy (GAEA) is a holistic two-year innovation program across 8 European countries, funneling leading ideas from regional to interregional scale, supported by bootcamp trainings, intensive workshops & tailored mentoring sessions, during incubation & acceleration phases. GAEA will end with a final pitching event where the final 5 teams will benefit from a funding pool to proceed to a start-up phase.

GAEA's ambition is to enhance entrepreneurial skills of youth in moderate innovation ecosystems, bringing together educational institutions & private organizations in a mutually beneficial way, building robust entrepreneurial ecosystems growth in EU countries that need it.
